Over 36 U.S. states now offer property tax exemptions for solar installations, so adding panels usually won't raise your property's assessed value or tax bill there.

Generally, if the solar PV system is used by a tax-exempt entity such as a school, municipal utility, government agency, or charity, the ITC may not be claimed.

Many states offer a full sales tax exemption for the purchase and installation of solar energy equipment. This exemption directly reduces the upfront cost of the system by eliminating the state and local ...

Solar power facilities may qualify as farm equipment and qualify for a partial exemption of the sales tax, currently 5.00 percent, for farming equipment and machinery that is primarily used in ...

For 2025, residential solar installations qualify for a 30% federal tax credit on the total system cost, including equipment and installation expenses. This credit applies to the full cost of ...

These facilities or property will be treated as a 5-year property for purposes of cost recovery, leaving them with lower taxable income in the earlier years of a clean energy investment.

Rooftop solar installers are steering customers toward leases instead of purchases. Federal tax credits for purchased systems have ended but are still available for leased ones.
