I just recently had this issue with dead batteries and a E01 code on my AIMS Power controller. I was told by the dealer to charge my batteries which did not rid the E01 code.

Sometimes the Renogy wanderer solar charge controller will give an error code. In order to fix this you need to unplug the solar panel then unplug the ...

Advise the customer that the battery may not charge well due to weather conditions. Recommend connecting to the grid to conserve energy. Clean the solar panels if covered with dust. Check the ...
